Jewish Identity in Jonathan Safran Foer's 'Everything is Illuminated' Jeroen Meylemans,2013 Jonathan Safran Foer published the novel *Everything is Illuminated* in 2002 At that point in time it had been 57 years since the end of the Holocaust Yet this particular author decided to write a novel centered on exactly this event even if the text does not show it directly The novel tells the story of the Jewish American Jonathan who goes on a quest for his ancestors shtetl A shtetl is a town with a large Jewish population in Central and Eastern Europe before the Holocaust At the same time the novel gives us a look at the history of Trachimbrod the shtetl in question Jonathan wrote this history during or after his trip We also get parts of an epistolary exchange in the novel between Jonathan and Alex his Ukrainian translator However we only get Alex part of that exchange Through the story of his trip and the imaginative history of Trachimbrod it is clear that the novel injects a lot of Jewish culture and identity in the novel What seems interesting to me is to research how the novel treats Jewish identity and culture What is the added value of another Holocaust novel Have we not had enough of this particular kind of novel besides the obvious need to record a personal history My thesis statement is that *Everything is Illuminated* is more than just a Holocaust novel In fact the novel comments on how we deal with the Holocaust and its surrounding issues *Everything is Illuminated* has a clear moral intent That moral message is that we perceive the Holocaust through the wrong lens That particular lens is very reductive and simplistic It does not help us in reckoning with this particular event As long as we stick to this lens we will never find peace We will never be able to treat the Holocaust in an appropriate manner

So They Remember Maksim Goldenshteyn, 2022-01-23 When we think of Nazi camps names such as Auschwitz Bergen Belsen and Dachau come instantly to mind Yet the history of the Holocaust extends beyond those notorious sites In the former territory of Transnistria located in occupied Soviet Ukraine and governed by Nazi Germany's Romanian allies many Jews perished due to disease starvation and other horrific conditions Through an intimate blending of memoir history and reportage So They Remember illuminates this oft overlooked chapter of the Holocaust In December 1941 with the German led invasion of the Soviet Union in its sixth month a twelve year old Jewish boy named Motl Braverman along with family members was uprooted from his Ukrainian hometown and herded to the remote village of Pechera the site of a Romanian death camp Author Maksim Goldenshteyn the grandson of Motl first learned of his family's wartime experiences in 2012 Through tireless research Goldenshteyn spent years unraveling the story of Motl his family members and their fellow prisoners The author here renders their story through the eyes of Motl and other children who decades later would bear witness to the traumas they suffered Until now Romanian historians and survivors have served as almost the only chroniclers of the Holocaust in Transnistria Goldenshteyn's account based on interviews with Soviet born relatives and other survivors archival documents and memoirs is among the first full length books to spotlight the Pechera camp ominously known by its prisoners as Mertvaya Petlya or the Death Noose Unfortunately as the author explains the Pechera camp was only one of some two hundred concentration sites spread across Transnistria where local Ukrainian policemen often conspired with Romanian guards to brutalize the prisoners In March 1944 the Red Army liberated Motl's family and fellow captives Yet for decades according to the author they were silenced by Soviet policies enacted to erase all memory of Jewish wartime suffering So They Remember gives voice to this long repressed history and documents how the events at Pechera and other surrounding camps and ghettos would continue to shape remaining survivors and their descendants

Illumination of Solitude Mina Grčar, 2015 Everything is Illuminated the debut novel by Jonathan Safran Foer has been acclaimed for its experimental form employed to convey his tragic family past embittered by

the shadow of the Holocaust Foer's turn to fictionalization and magical realism seems to evoke *One Hundred Years of Solitude* the world literature masterpiece by the Colombian Nobel Laureate Gabriel García Márquez In their respective novels each of the two authors tries to express past issues which makes the reader feel their choice of the magical realist mode could not have been a coincidence The purpose of the following literary analysis is to illuminate the reasons for the two authors writing within different cultural contexts and in different spirits of the era to opt for such a style One can sense that Foer's novel is charged with the difficult and painful topic of the Holocaust and that García Márquez is trying to express the cruel colonial history of Colombia in a somewhat less direct way As the paper will point out in the following chapters traumatic experiences of any kind either the experience of colonial rule repression and forceful conversion to the culture of the colonizers or the trauma of totalitarian regimes and war all prove problematic to transcribe due to the inexpressibility of the horrific truth behind them Due to the limitations of language to describe them as well as the temporal distance or suppression of truth and historical facts the collective memory of the past is often ruptured not clear or even completely unknown to younger generations The latter hence struggle to reconstruct their families and their peoples forgotten histories within a particular cultural environment Authors retreat to magical realism to show the multilayered nature of truth and human memory While the absolute single variant of truth is unattainable impossible to grasp and to be shed light upon magical realism with its narrative possibilities is able to capture the emotional essence associated with the times gone by This literary issue is of particular urgency with regards to the Holocaust which was an experience so terrible it defies expression through ordinary language Another reason for the novel to take the magical realist form is the unknowability of the past Fictionalizing the story of the Holocaust and infusing it with elements of superstition exaggeration and the extraordinary thus provide the author with the means to express the inexpressible *Everything is Illuminated* presents an alternative version of Foer's family history blending the styles and techniques of the great magical realist authors like Günter Grass Salman Rushdie Toni Morrison Maxine Hong Kingston and above all Gabriel García Márquez The influence of the latter is evident in the style the motifs and symbols and the settings of the narratives while the strongest similarity between the two novels is the content that resists realist description namely the repression under the colonial rule and the terror of totalitarian regimes in Colombian history or the horrific violence performed by the Nazis during WWII By rejecting the concept of a singular version of historical truth acknowledging a multiplicity of possible perspectives presenting a cyclical concept of history and the absence of any real difference between truth and fiction magical realist texts allow for mythologized accounts and dreams to assume a position equally valid to the conventionally real In his family saga Foer reshapes the events from the birth of his ancestry to the bombing of Trachimbrod inflating the narrative with what seems too implausible or extraordinary to have actually happened This authorial move is to point to the fact that history is always multilayered and can never be fully illuminated or viewed from a single perspective if one wants to see the larger picture and

feel the memories breathing from behind the veils of the past
